

Principles of Spiritual Warfare

Exodus 14:13, 14	God fights for us.
Exodus 15	God destroys the enemy.
Exodus 17	As we support one another in prayer, Jesus (Joshua) defeats the enemy.
Numbers 23:8, 20	God turns enemy curses into blessing for us.
Joshua 6	We surround enemy strongholds with prayer and praise. God causes the walls to collapse.
Joshua 10	Don't be afraid. (v. 8, 25) God causes the enemy forces to be confused so that they are defeated. (v. 10) "But don't stop! Pursue your enemies, . . . for the LORD your God has given them into your hand." (v. 19) Expose the lies (the five kings). (v. 22)
1 Samuel 17	God enables us (David) to come against spiritual giants (divorce).
2 Kings 7	God causes the enemy to panic and flee.
2 Kings 18	We must not listen to enemy lies; we must trust our King instead.
2 King 19	We "spread out" our situation to the Lord and acknowledge Him alone as God. We ask God to turn back the enemy (v. 32, 33) and to defend us (v. 34). God destroys the enemy.
2 Chronicles 20	Praise and worship bring victory. "As [God's people] began to sing and praise, the LORD set ambushes against the [enemy forces] who were invading..., and they were defeated." (v. 22)

Isaiah 25:12	God tears down satanic strongholds.
Hosea 2:6-7 , 12	God blocks the way of the rebel to bring repentance.
Hosea 2:14	God speaks tenderly to woo the runaway.
Zechariah 8-10	God is passionate for His people. Because of the blood covenant, God frees spiritual prisoners from their pits. He returns them to His fortress of hope, and He restores what had been lost. He will make His people beautiful and joyful. God will destroy the enemy's power, and He will strengthen His people as they walk through suffering.
